Volunteer Days

Further to the last meeting, our volunteer days have been successful and we have had some new faces attend. This summer we have targeted the bridleway to let some sunshine shine onto the path to hopefully help with the continuous drainage problems, but we all know it won't resolved all of it.

Red and Green Routes

As you might have seen if you have been in the Valley or seen on Facebook, we have now got two walking routes in the Valley. The Green route is for all abilities, benches are 110 meters apart. The Red route has some inclines and benches are 180 meters apart.
